

## Market Alerts

**BELL PEPPERS** Supplies of all **Green Bell Peppers** have tightened, particularly in the Eastern U.S. growing regions, and will remain so for a week or two. Quality is good, but pricing may be higher in certain markets. **Choice-grade Green Bells** are the best value.

**CUCUMBERS** Pricing on **Super Select-grade Cucumbers** may be higher than normal due to light supplies. Be sure to use **Select-Grade** product wherever possible, for optimal quality and pricing.

**TENDER LEAF LETTUCE** Extreme heat in California's growing regions is beginning to affect quality on **Spinach, Arugula, and Spring Mix**. Withering and short shelf life are the most common issues being reported.

**LEMONS** Extreme heat in the western growing regions for citrus has caused a shortage of all sizes of **Lemons** that is expected to last for several weeks. Orders may be shorted or substituted with a different size or grade, pricing is much higher than normal, and quality is fair to poor. The best buy will be **115 CT** and **larger choice-grade** fruit, where available.

## A Peek at Peak Seasons

**Stone Fruit:** California, Georgia and South Carolina are producing great Peaches, Nectarines and Plums.

**Asparagus:** Quality is very nice and pricing is good on Pencil- and Standard-size Asparagus.

**Blueberries:** California and New Jersey are producing great quality berries.

**Melons:** Cantaloupe and Honeydew are very nice quality, with high sugar levels. Specialty melons such as Casaba, Galia and Juan Canary are also now in season.

**Leaf Lettuce:** Green Leaf, Red Leaf and Romaine Lettuce are plentiful, with great quality and low pricing. Great alternatives to Iceberg!

**Summer Squash:** California and most of the Southeast and Mid-Atlantic growing regions are producing very good quality Yellow and Zucchini Squash.

The local growing season for most of the U.S. is heating up. Be sure to ask your distributor for locally grown recommendations!

## Weather Update

**California:** Coastal showers, and temperatures well above normal in all growing regions.

**Mexico:** Seasonally warm temperatures and humid conditions in the Central regions, and above average temps in the North.

**Southeastern U.S.:** Widespread showers and thunderstorms and seasonal temperatures.
