Market Alerts

STONE FRUIT The season is coming to an early end due to poor growing conditions throughout the year. Quality is fair, sizing is running large and pricing is higher than normal.

ASPARAGUS Quality is good on all sizes, with higher pricing on larger sizes. **Pencil and Standard** are the best buys.

ORANGES Supplies of **Valencia Oranges** are becoming scarce on smaller sizes due to excessive heat in Western growing areas, with **113** and **138 CT Choice** being the least available. Quality is good to fair. The situation is expected to continue until the **Navel Orange** harvest begins in the fall. Consider using **88 CT** or larger, or a **Fancy** grade if needed.

BRUSSELS SPROUTS Supplies are very limited, particularly on Jumbo sizes, and pricing is higher than normal. Quality is fair to good.

AVOCADOS The supply situation remains critically tight, particularly with the Mexican harvest, which accounts for the majority of available product. Quality is good to fair, however pricing is at record highs.

WESTERN SOFT VEGETABLES Heat-related harvest issues in California have affected supplies of Red Bell Peppers, Eggplant and Cucumbers. We recommend using Green Bell Peppers and Select-grade Cucumbers as good value alternatives.

A Peek at Peak Seasons

Locally Grown Products: The local growing season is at its peak in most areas of the country! Be sure to ask your distributor for their full list of locally grown recommendations, and look for these farm-fresh products:

Melons: All melons are peaking in quality and availability. Cantaloupe, Honeydew, Watermelon and specialty melons like Crenshaw and Persian are all perfect summer menu features.

Tomatoes: Locally grown in late summer throughout the country, with Beefsteak, Heirlooms and other specialty tomatoes available in many regions. Ask your distributor for recommendations.

Red and Green Leaf Lettuce: Excellent quality and pricing are reported on Leaf Lettuce, with locally grown product available throughout the Midwest, Northeast and Mid-Atlantic.

Green Bell Peppers: Harvests in the Midwest, Northeast and California are all peaking. Great quality and pricing on all grades and sizes of Green Peppers.

Weather Update

California: All growing regions will grow hotter and drier throughout the week. Inland region temperatures will be in the 100s and the coastal areas in the mid-80s.

Mexico: Northern Mexico will also be hotter and drier, into the 100s. The Central region will be at seasonal temperatures and precipitation, and the Southern area may be affected by incoming Tropical Storm Harvey.

Florida: Tropical storms are expected to bring heavy rain to the southern part of the state over the weekend. The rest of the state is at seasonal temperatures and precipitation.
